BACKGROUND

CAPER (the Canadian Post-M.D. Education Registry) was established in 1986 through the cooperation of national medical organizations with an interest in the Post-M.D. clinical education of physicians in Canada. The Association of Canadian Medical Colleges, The Canadian Association of Internes and Residents, The Canadian Medical Association, The College of Family Physicians of Canada, Health and Welfare Canada, and the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, have provided both expertise and financial support for the development and operation of CAPER. CAPER is incorporated within the by-laws of the Association of Canadian Medical Colleges.

The mandate of CAPER is to provide accurate information which may be used for medical manpower planning on a national basis. To accomplish this task, an individual longitudinal file is maintained containing socio-demographic information, details of the current training program and career goal plans of each intern, resident or fellow under the supervision of the Canadian Faculties of Medicine on November 1 of each year. The data in this document are derived from information submitted for November 1, 1989.

HISTORIQUE

CAPER (système informatisé sur les stagiaires post-M.D. en formation clinique) a été établi en 1986 avec la coopération de diverses organisations médicales du Canada intéressées à la formation clinique post-M.D. au Canada. L'Association des facultés de médecine du Canada, l'Association canadienne des internes et des résidents, l'Association médicale canadienne, le Collège des médecins de famille du Canada, Santé et bien-être social Canada, ainsi que le Collège royal des médecins et chirurgiens du Canada ont contribué au développement et au bon fonctionnement de CAPER en partageant leurs connaissances et en y apportant un support financier. CAPER est constitué en société et fonctionne selon les arrêtés de l'Association des facultés de médecine du Canada.

Le mandat de CAPER est de fournir des renseignements précis pouvant être utilisés pour fins de planification de la main-d'oeuvre médicale au niveau national. Pour ce faire, un fichier longitudinal est tenu à jour contenant l'information pertinente à chaque interne, résident ou "fellow" inscrit aux différentes facultés de médecine canadiennes en date du 1er nov. de chaque année. L'information socio-démographique, les détails du programme de formation ainsi que l'orientation professionnelle y sont inclus. Les données de ce document reflètent l'information soumise au 1er nov. 1989.

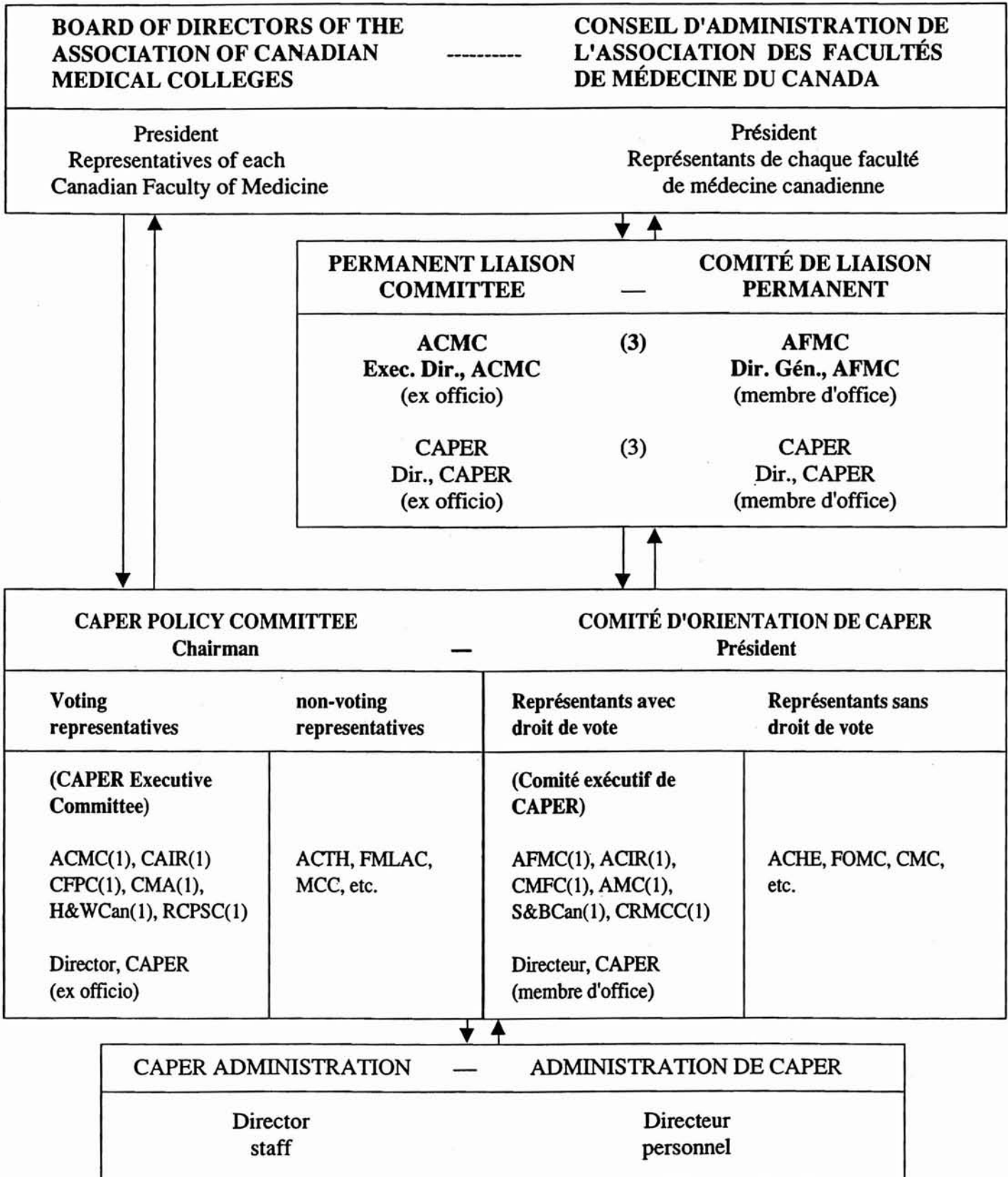

THE REPORTING PROCESS

The individual records of all trainees under the supervision of each Canadian Faculty of Medicine are provided to CAPER by the postgraduate medical education office of the respective Faculty. All Post-M.D. trainees (interns, residents, and fellows) in training positions on Nov. 1 of the current academic year are reported to CAPER. The following information is included in the yearly report:

- The Faculty of Medicine supervising post-M.D. training;
- Socio-demographic details;
- Previous medical education and certification;
- Field of current post-M.D. training; and
- Professional goal and date of completion of training.

This information is collected by all Faculties at the time of registration for Post-M.D. training each year and is sent to CAPER, in coded form, on diskette or magnetic tape. Information sent to CAPER is checked for missing or incorrect items. Reports are then sent back to the appropriate postgraduate medical education office of the Canadian Faculties of Medicine for further verification of the information on their trainees.

Confidentiality of individual records

The individual information provided by the Faculties of Medicine for the CAPER database is kept in confidence. The CAPER policy concerning the confidentiality of individual records guarantees that individual information is not released from CAPER:

"Although information will be collected and maintained in the form of individual records, UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES will individual records be released or disclosed. A Faculty of Medicine, however, will be able to retrieve the individual records which have been submitted to CAPER by that faculty. This policy applies to all individuals and organizations including the participating organizations of CAPER."

PROCÉDURE DE CUEILLETTE

Les bureaux de formation post-M.D. de chaque faculté de médecine fournissent à CAPER les rapports contenant les données sur les stagiaires de leur propre faculté. Le rapport fait à CAPER inclut l'information sur tous les stagiaires post-M.D. (internes, résidents, associés ou moniteurs/boursiers) qui sont inscrits en date du 1er novembre de chaque année. Les renseignements suivants sont inclus dans le rapport annuel:

- la faculté de médecine offrant la formation post-M.D.;
- détails sociodémographiques;
- formation médicale antérieure et certification;
- domaine de formation en cours; et
- orientation professionnelle et date prévue de la fin de la formation clinique.

A chaque année, les facultés de médecine recueillent les renseignements lors de l'inscription pour la formation post-M.D. et font parvenir le tout à CAPER sous forme de codes, soit sur ruban ou sur disquette. Le personnel de CAPER vérifie cette information afin de déceler les omissions et les inexactitudes. Les rapports sont ensuite retournés aux bureaux post-M.D. de chaque faculté de médecine canadienne afin que les renseignements soient vérifiés de nouveau.

Confidentialité de l'information personnelle

L'information personnelle fournie par les facultés de médecine et insérée dans la base de données de CAPER est strictement confidentielle. La politique de CAPER concernant la confidentialité de l'information personnelle assure que les renseignements individuels ne soient pas divulgués:

"Bien que l'information soit recueillie et gardée sous forme de fiches individuelles, ces renseignements ne seront divulgués ou révélés EN AUCUN CAS. Par ailleurs, une faculté de médecine pourra récupérer les fiches individuelles qu'elle aura soumises à CAPER. Cette politique s'applique à tous les individus et à toutes les organisations incluant les organismes participants dans CAPER."

DEFINITIONS

The data provided to CAPER by the sixteen Faculties of Medicine contain the information on each trainee in accordance with definitions established by CAPER. Following are these definitions and other important details pertaining to the specific variables used in the tables presented in this document.

Faculty of medicine providing post-M.D. Training

The Faculty of Medicine supervising the Post-M.D. trainee on Nov. 1 of the report year.

Field of Post-M.D. Training

The type of non-specialized training, Family Medicine training, or the speciality field in which a trainee is enrolled on Nov. 1 of the report year.

Rank

The variable describing the rank of trainees is the actual training level of a trainee in the intern or residency ranking system at the individual faculties of medicine. Trainees pass through the ranking system in two ways depending on whether the first year of post-M.D. training is a specialized or a non-specialized year of training.

1. Post-M.D. year 1 (specialized year or Family Medicine)
 - R-2
 - R-3
 - R-4
 - R-5

2. Post-M.D. year 1 (non-specialized training)
 - R-1 (first year of a speciality)
 - R-2
 - R-3
 - R-4
 - R-5

If this route is chosen, a trainee would take 6 years to complete a 5 year speciality training program.

The following details concerning the ranking system in specific provinces are to be noted:

DÉFINITIONS

Les données, fournies par les seize facultés de médecine à CAPER, contiennent les renseignements concernant chaque stagiaire suivant les définitions établies par CAPER. Ces définitions, ainsi que d'autres détails importants relatifs aux variables spécifiques utilisées dans les tableaux présentés dans ce document, sont énoncés ci-après.

Faculté de médecine offrant des stages post-M.D.

La faculté de médecine supervisant le stagiaire d'un programme post-M.D. au 1er novembre de l'année du rapport.

Domaine des stages post-M.D.

Le genre de stage non spécialisé, de médecine de famille, ou la spécialité auquel le stagiaire s'est inscrit au 1er novembre de l'année du rapport.

Grade

La variable décrivant le grade des stagiaires est représenté par le niveau de stage réel du stagiaire selon le système de classement d'internat ou de résidence de chaque faculté de médecine. Les stagiaires sont classifiés suivant le genre de stage de leur première année post-M.D., soit un stage spécialisé ou soit une stage nonspecialisé.

1. Première année post-M.D. (stage spécialisé ou de médecine de famille)
 - R-2

2. Première année post-M.D. (stage non spécialisé)

En choisissant cette filière, le stagiaire mettra 6 ans pour accomplir un programme de stage de 5 années.

USING THE CAPER DATABASE

The Caper database has been designed to serve as an information resource for medical manpower planning on a national basis in Canada. Information is held in an individual longitudinal format to permit the study of the flow of trainees through the post-M.D. training system. Although individual information is not released from CAPER, with the approval of the CAPER Executive Committee, group data tabulations and statistics will be prepared in response to requests. Preparation will be on a cost-recovery basis. Examples of some of the categories into which tabulations can be grouped are: provinces, training fields, or cohorts of M.D. graduates. The CAPER database has been designed to study the mobility of trainees between faculties of medicine, provinces and training fields. Data requests made to CAPER are welcome.

UTILISATION DE LA BASE DE DONNÉES DE CAPER

La base de données de CAPER fut conçue comme source d'information pour la planification de la main d'oeuvre médicale au niveau national. L'information est cueillie sous forme de fiches longitudinales individuelles afin de pouvoir obtenir un vue d'ensemble des stagiaires inscrits à la formation post-M.D. Bien que l'information sous forme individuelle ne puisse pas être divulguée, il est possible de répondre aux demandes de statistiques sous forme de groupe avec l'approbation du Comité exécutif de CAPER. Ce service est offert à prix coûtant. Les données peuvent être groupées selon les catégories suivantes: provinces, domaines de formation ou cohortes de stagiaires post-M.D.. La base de données fut conçue pour permettre l'étude de la mobilité des stagiaires entre facultés de médecine, provinces et domaines de formation. Toutes demandes de statistiques devront être faites en s'adressant à CAPER:

Source of Funding

The source of funding is the organization or government agency providing the funding for the position occupied by the trainee. Two categories are used: "Regular Ministry Funds" and "Other Funds". "Regular Ministry Funds" refers to funds provided by the appropriate provincial government ministry responsible for the training of interns and residents within that province. All other funding sources are grouped as "Other Funds".

Age

Age is calculated as the age of the trainee on July 1, 1990. (The age of the trainee at the beginning of the July 1990 training session.)

Career Goal

This is the professional goal as indicated by the trainee at the time of registration for post-M.D. training in July 1990. In most cases it is the same as field of training. However, it may differ. For example, many trainees in rotating internships have a career in a specialty. Often trainees in internal medicine or surgery have a sub-specialty as a career goal.

Legal Status

Three categories are used:

Canadian Citizen:

trainee is a citizen of Canada.

Permanent Resident:

an individual who been accepted as a landed immigrant and has the right to live and work in Canada.

Visa:

trainees holding a visa permitting employment in Canada temporarily as a post-M.D. trainee.

Source de financement

La source de financement est l'organisme ou l'agence gouvernementale qui fournit le financement pour la position occupée par le stagiaire. Deux catégories sont utilisées: "Fonds ministériels habituels" et "Autres fonds". Les "fonds ministériels habituels" sont les fonds provenant des ministères des gouvernements provinciaux appropriés responsables des stages des internes et des résidents au sein de la province. Tous les autres sources de financement sont regroupés sous l'appellation "Autres fonds".

Âge

L'âge est calculé en fonction de l'âge du stagiaire au 1er juillet 1990. (L'âge du stagiaire au commencement de la séance de stage de juillet 1990).

But de carrière

C'est le but professionnel indiqué par le stagiaire au moment de l'inscription pour le stage post-M.D. en juillet 1990. Dans la plupart des cas, c'est le même que le domaine de stage post-M.D. Cependant il se peut qu'il y ait des différences. Par exemple: de nombreux stagiaires en internat rotatoire ont une spécialité de carrière. Souvent, les stagiaires en médecine interne ou en chirurgie ont une sous-spécialité comme but de carrière.

Statut légal

On utilise trois catégories:

Citoyen canadien:

le stagiaire est citoyen canadien

Résident permanent:

British Columbia:

At the University of British Columbia, nearly all trainees are registered and reported to CAPER as being at the R-2 level in the second year of training even though the trainee is in the first year of a speciality training program. Because Fellows at the University of British Columbia are not registered with the office of Postgraduate Medical Education, they are not included in the CAPER data.

Fellows: CAPER uses the following definition of the term "Fellow": A post-M.D. trainee who is registered with the Postgraduate Medical Education Office of a University Faculty of Medicine and who, regardless of the source of funding, is pursuing clinical or research training which will NOT be evaluated by the supervising faculty for the purpose of Canadian licensure, or certification by the College of Family Physicians of Canada, la Corporation professionnelle des médecins du Québec, or the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada.

Location of the faculty of medicine that awarded the M.D. Degree

For individuals who earned the degree in Canada, the province of location of faculty of medicine that awarded the M.D. degree is used. Post-M.D. trainees who earned the M.D. degree outside Canada are classified as such.

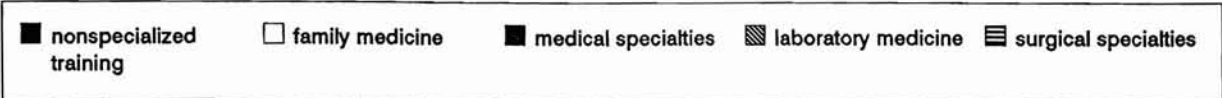

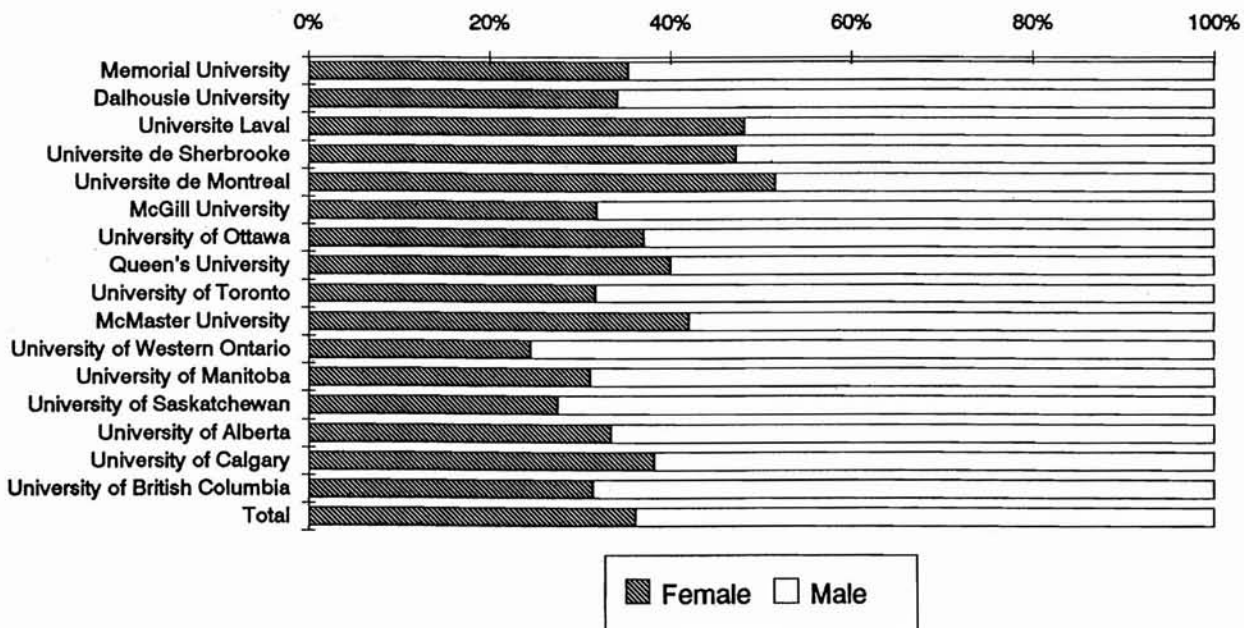

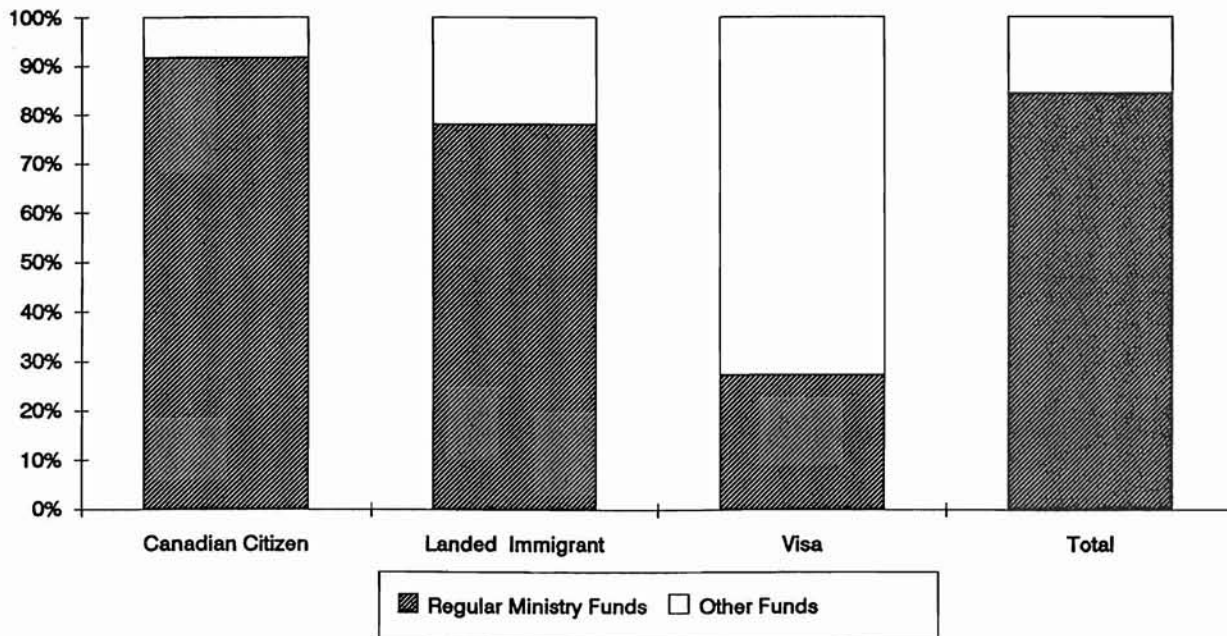
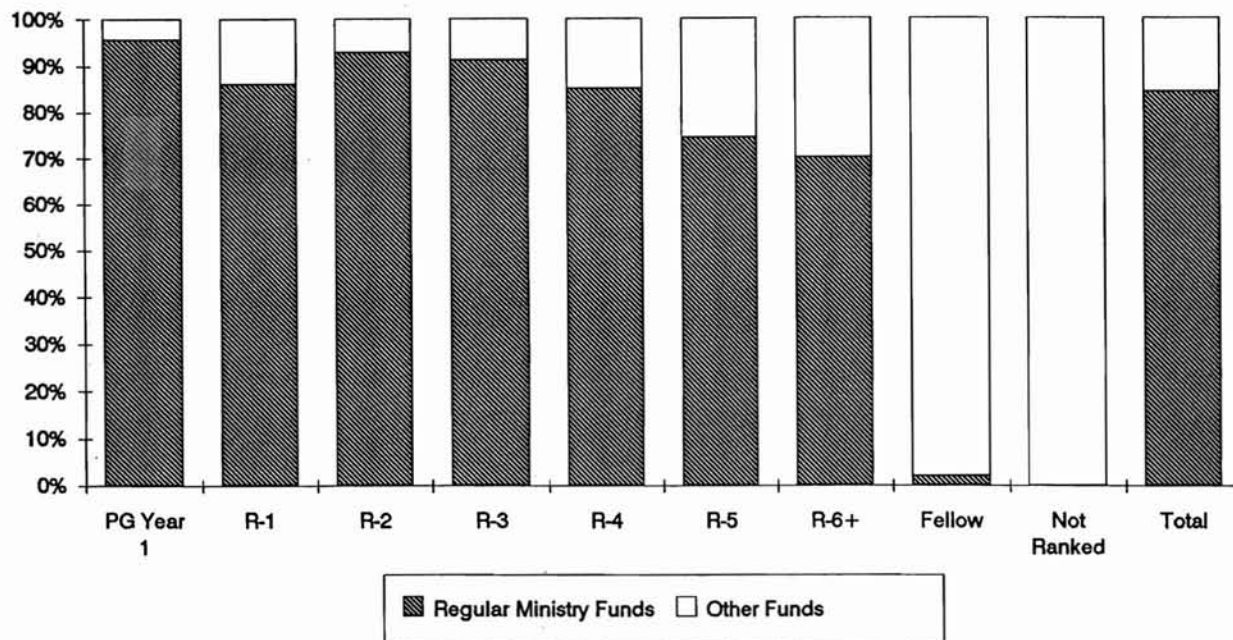

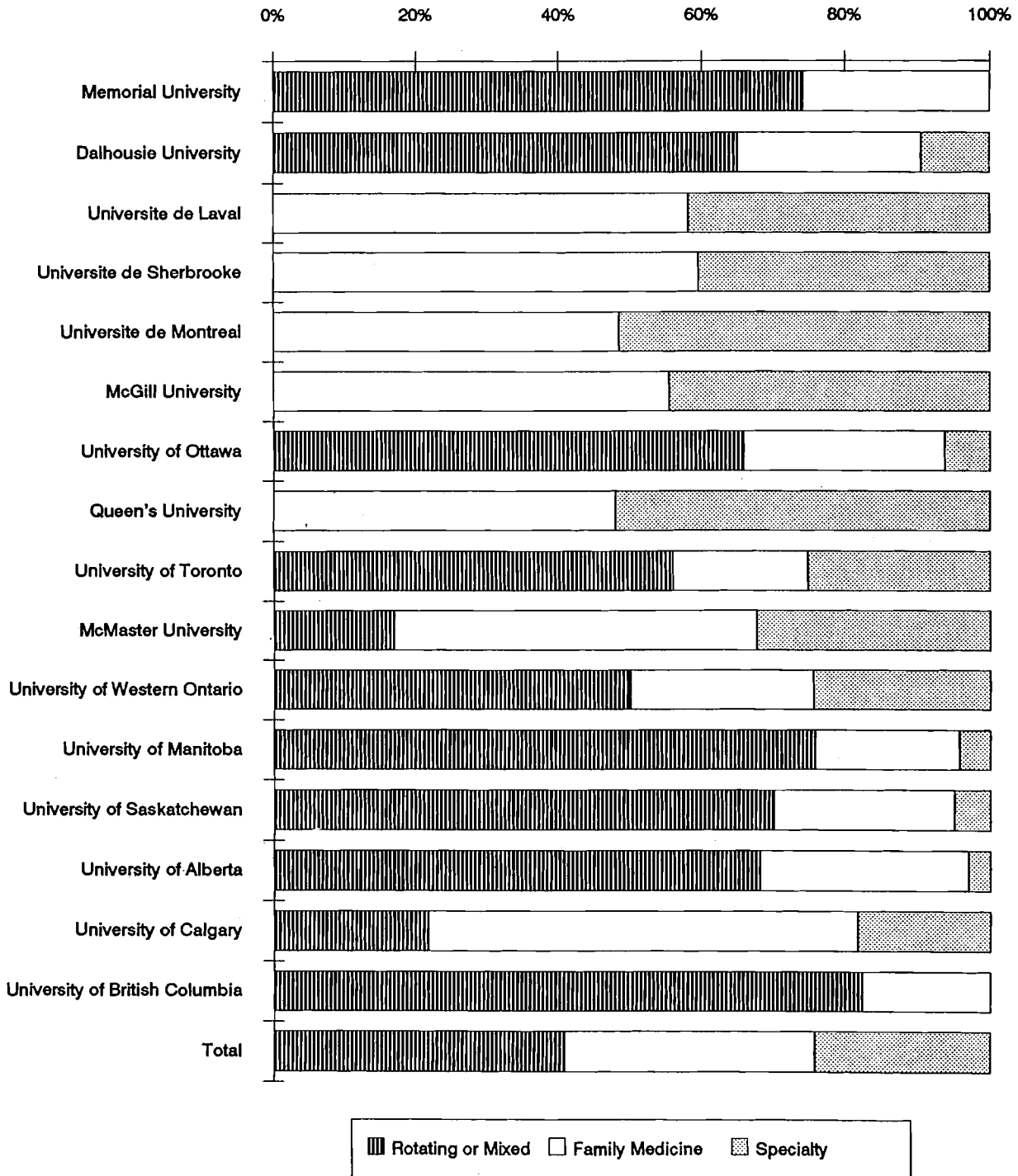

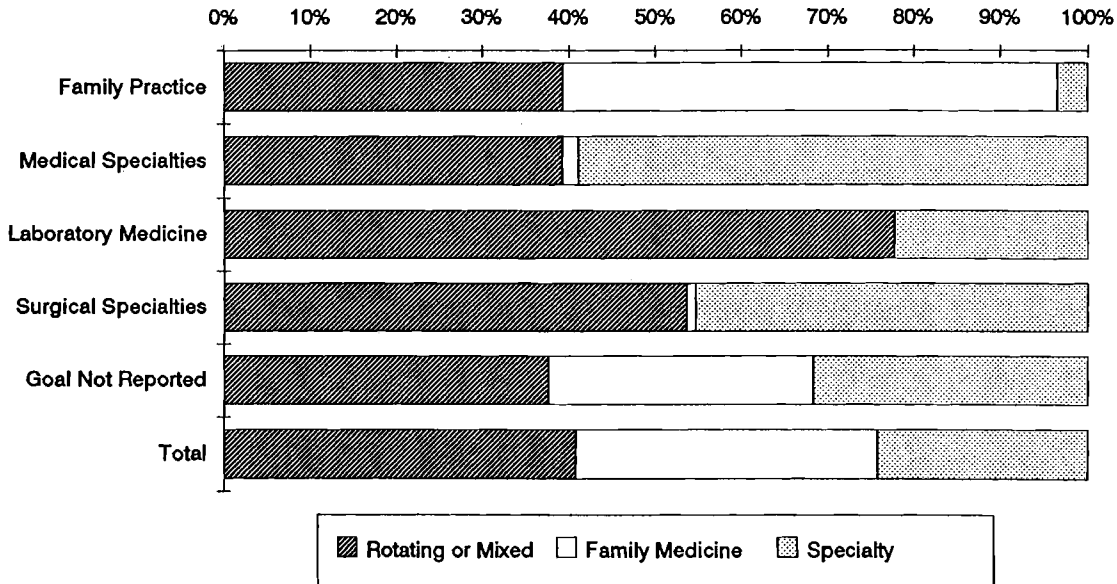

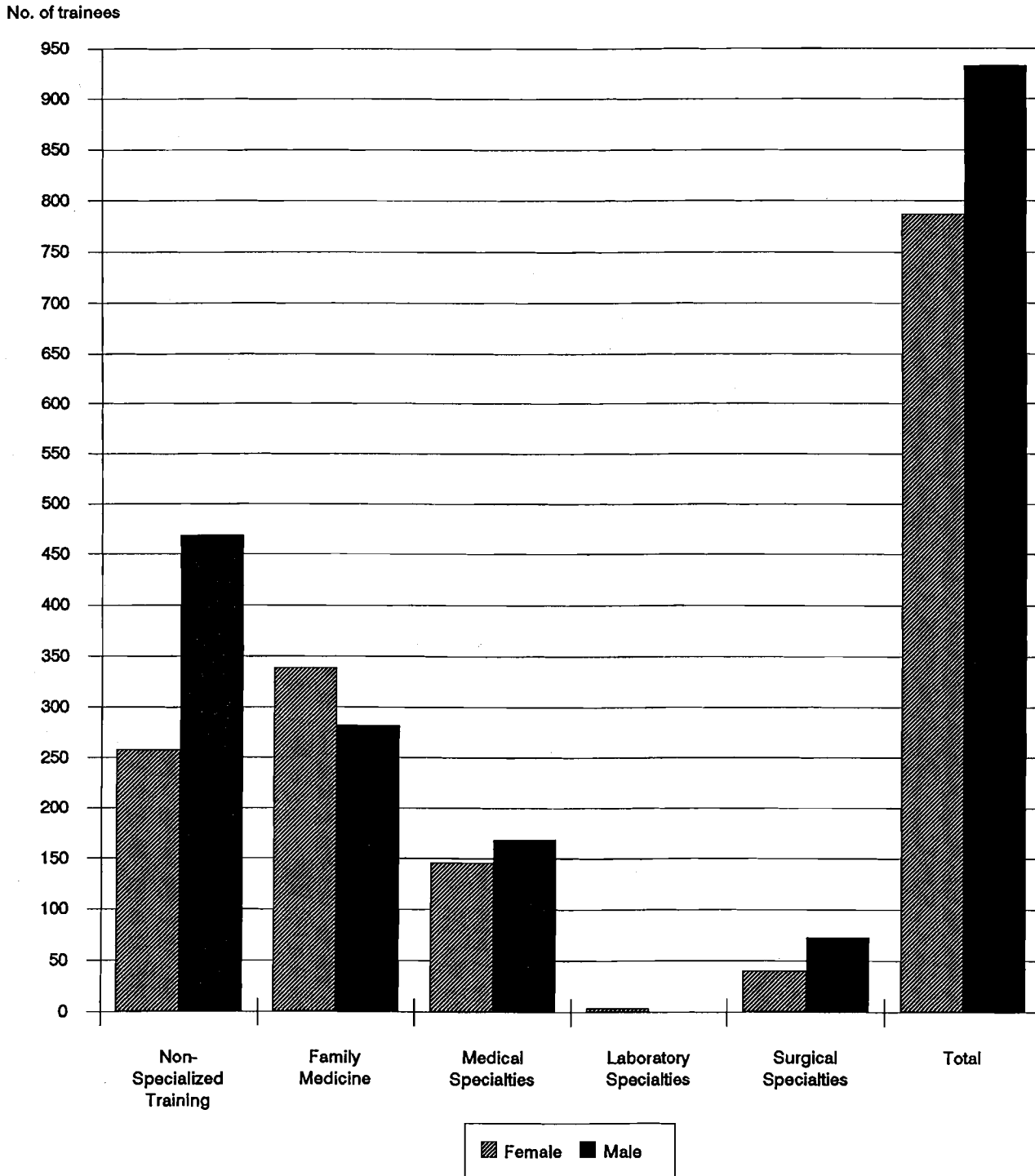

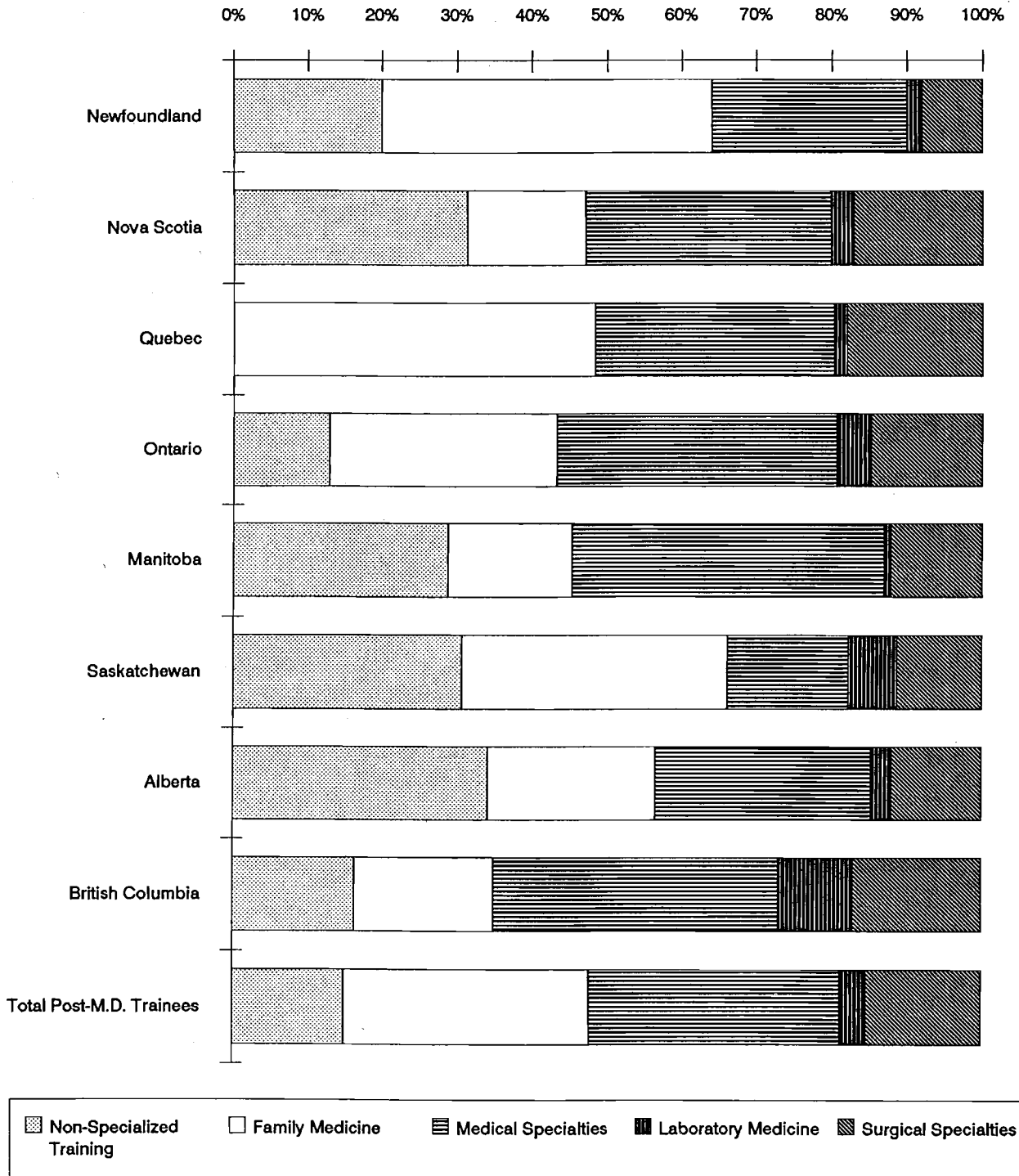

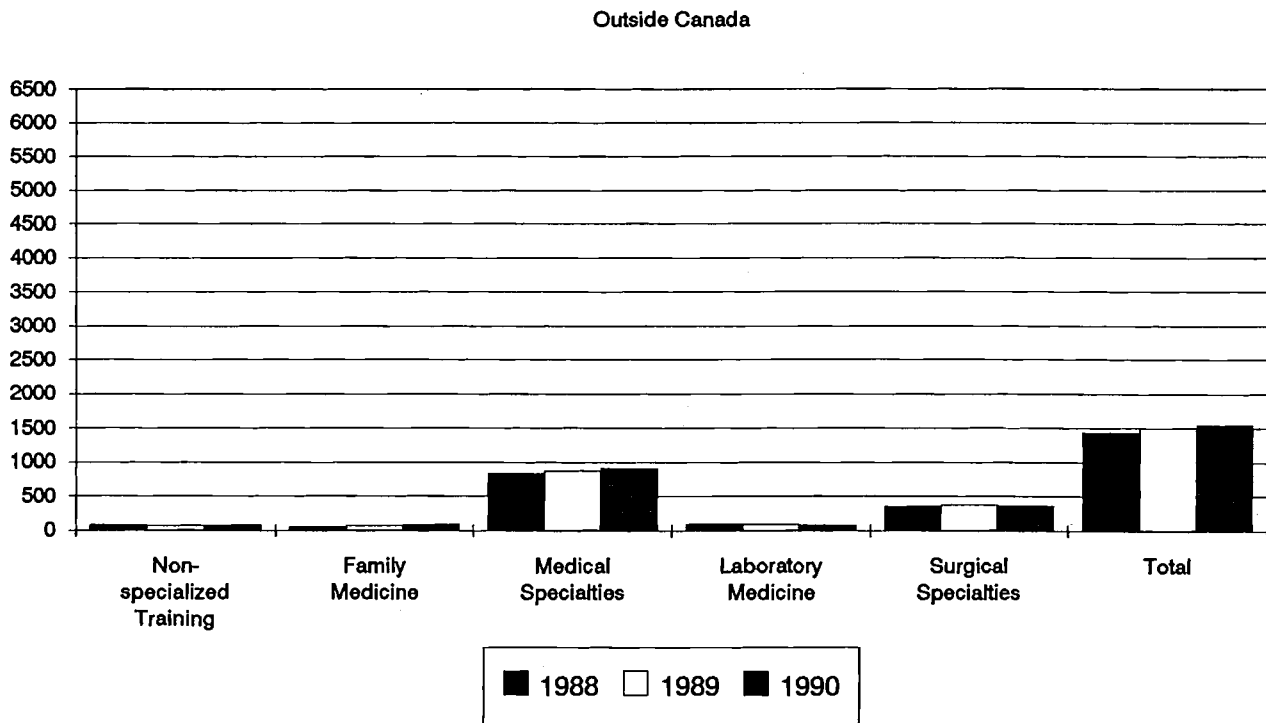
